



Science underpinning the EU 2020 Biodiversity Strategy

Together with the European Commission, ALTER-Net is proud to host a major conference on science to support the European Union's Biodiversity Strategy.

The primary focus of the conference will be the objectives and targets of the EU's 2020 Biodiversity Strategy, which should be realized by the end of this decade. Being a science-policy interface network, ALTER-Net wants to help the EU in realizing these targets by providing scientific knowledge, e.g. by pointing out possible weaknesses, opportunities and requirements, and by helping to find solutions and evidence-based actions.

The conference will be a mixture of plenary and parallel sessions on each of the six EU biodiversity targets, discussion workshops and a range of side events. Speakers will be invited by the Organising Committee and there will be an open invitation to present posters within the scope of the EU targets.

Representatives of several European networks and projects will also be present, including Liaise, MarBEF (ALTER-Net's sister network covering marine ecosystems) and the emerging Biodiversity Knowledge network of knowledge.
